I Mr. Hemant Shetye -partner of HS Associates, Practicing Company Secretaries, had been appointed as the Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of **Sunil Industries Limited** pursuant to section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014, to conduct the remote e-voting process and to scrutinize the physical ballot forms received from the shareholders in respect of the below mentioned resolutions passed at 39<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting of the Company on 26<sup>th</sup> day of September,2015 at D 8 MIDC Phase II Manpada Road, Dombivli (East), Thane,— 421021 at 3.00 pm.

The voting rights were reckoned as on Saturday, the 19<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015 being the Cut off date for the purpose of deciding the entitlements of members at the remote e-voting at the meeting.

The Company had availed the e-voting facility offered by Central Depository Services (India) Limited (CDSL) for extending the facility of remote e-voting to the members of the Company from Wednesday, the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of September, 2015 (9.00 a.m. IST) to Friday, the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015 (5.00 p.m. IST) at the said Annual General Meeting held on Saturday, the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015

The votes cast under remote e-voting facility were thereafter unblocked in the presence of two witnesses who were not in the employment of the company and after the conclusion of the voting at the Annual General Meeting the votes cast there under were counted. Votes cast through Physical ballot forms received up to Friday, the 25<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2015 till 5.00 p.m were also considered.

The Company had also provided voting facility to the shareholders present at the Annual General Meeting and who had not cast their vote earlier through remote e-voting facility or by physical ballot.
